Comparing the Ontario Libertarian Platform to other parties in the Oct. 6, 2011 Election

Education	McGuinty in 2003 promised that 75% of students would meet provincial standards, but even after huge funding increases, 60% is the current level, no change from previous governments. McGuinty began costly full-day kindergarten; removed tax breaks for parents that send children to private schools and generally reduced choices while increasing the cost. The PC's and NDP promise to continue these policies with very minor differences.			Allow parents to direct their tax money to a school of their choice allowing schools to compete based on their ability to produce high quality results.
Governance and Taxation	A record of intrusive and arbitrary new laws plus huge budget increases from \$62 billion in 2003-04 to \$122 billion in 2011-12.	Promise to continue deficit spending with slow reduction thus increasing the debt through to 2017.	Continue deficit spending with a mixed bag of tax increases and decreases hoping for a balanced budget.	Quickly phase out ministries and agencies. Eliminate deficit spending and reduce spending to 2003-04 levels in the first mandate. Sell off land/assets to reduce debt.

The Ontario Libertarian Party advocates competition instead of government monopoly.

Therefore, we would:

- ⇒ Provide greater choices to parents and students in elementary, secondary and post secondary education.
- ⇒ Remove the government monopoly on the sale of liquor, beer, and wine in Ontario.
- ⇒ Cancel high fee contracts for electricity generation from wind and solar power and secure the future of Ontario's Power Grid.
- ⇒ Allow a competitive medical care system to eliminate deadly wait times in Ontario.
